## GRADES 7-12 QUALIFYING AT-RISK CRITERIA

### AREA LEARNING CENTERS AND ALTERNATIVE PROGRAMS

- (A) any pupil under the age of 21 who:
- (1) performs substantially below the performance level for pupils of the same age in a locally determined achievement test; or
  - (2) is at least one year behind in satisfactorily completing coursework or obtaining credits for graduation; or
  - (3) is pregnant or is a parent; or
  - (4) has been assessed as chemically dependent; or
  - (5) has been excluded or expelled according to sections 127.26 to 127.39; or
  - (6) has been referred by a school district\* for enrollment in an eligible program or a program pursuant to section 126.23 **Renumbered 124D.69**; or
  - (7) is a victim of physical or sexual abuse; or
  - (8) has experienced mental health problems; or
  - (9) has experienced homelessness sometime within six months before requesting transfer to an eligible program; or
  - (10) speaks English as a second language or has limited English proficiency; or
  - (11) has withdrawn from school or has been chronically truant; or
  - (12) Graduation Standard/deficiency
