

**St. Cloud ALC Night School Program**

**Mission Statement:**

The purpose of night school is to provide opportunities for students from ALC or neighboring high schools to complete up to two semesters of additional credit. This program is available for qualifying students, enrolled full time in a mainstream or alternative program. It is not designed to serve as a primary program unless the student needs two or fewer semester credits to graduate.

**Entrance Criteria:**

Must be referred by home school or ALC counselor and qualify under High School Graduation Incentives Legislation.

**Referral/Enrollment Process:**

After referral by appropriate counselor, student would need to meet with the ALC Counselor. A counselor is available every Tuesday night at the Wilson building from 4:30 to 7:00 p.m.

**Description of Academic Program:**

The program includes the following courses/disciplines:

- Language Arts 10, 11, or 12
- Social Studies 12
- U.S. History
- Science
- Math
- Employability skills/work experience
- Physical Education

The subjects are taught on a one-to-one basis with students earning units for successful work completion. 60 units=1 semester credit, 40 units=1 trimester credit, 30 units=1 quarter credit.

**Description of School to Work Component:**

Employability skills is an option for night school.

**Program Schedule:**

Tuesday & Thursday nights from 5-8 p.m. Social, U.S. history and language arts classes are one hour in length.

**Parent Involvement:**

Parents are contacted on a need to know basis.

**Exit Criteria:**

Students who fail to attend will be sent one warning letter. If they do not respond in 5 days, they will be dropped.
