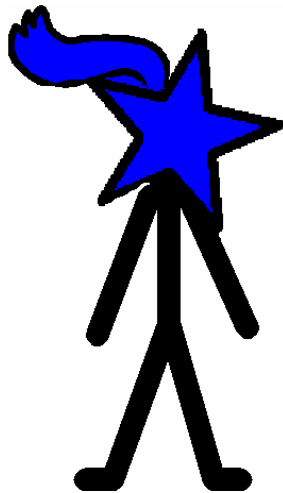
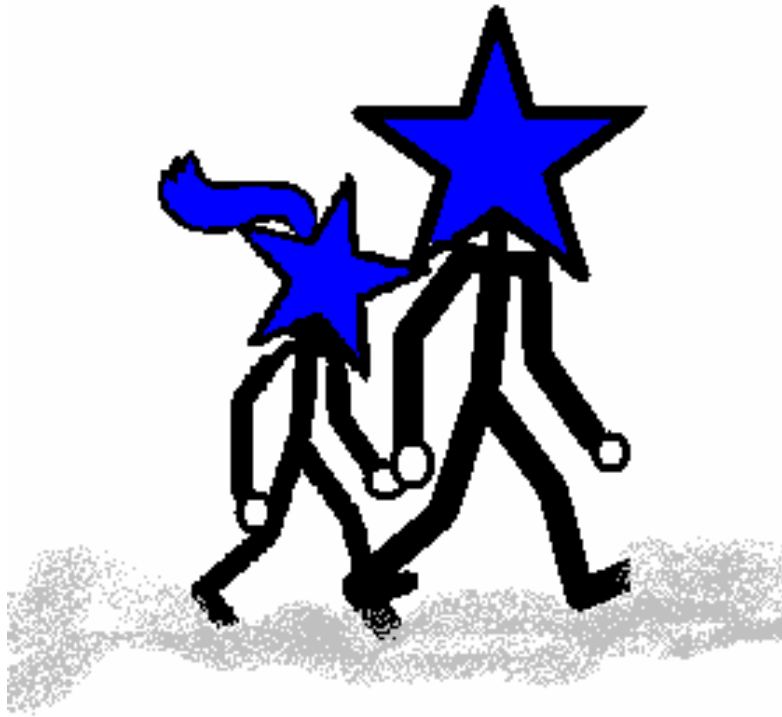


Star and Moon Walk Down The Hall

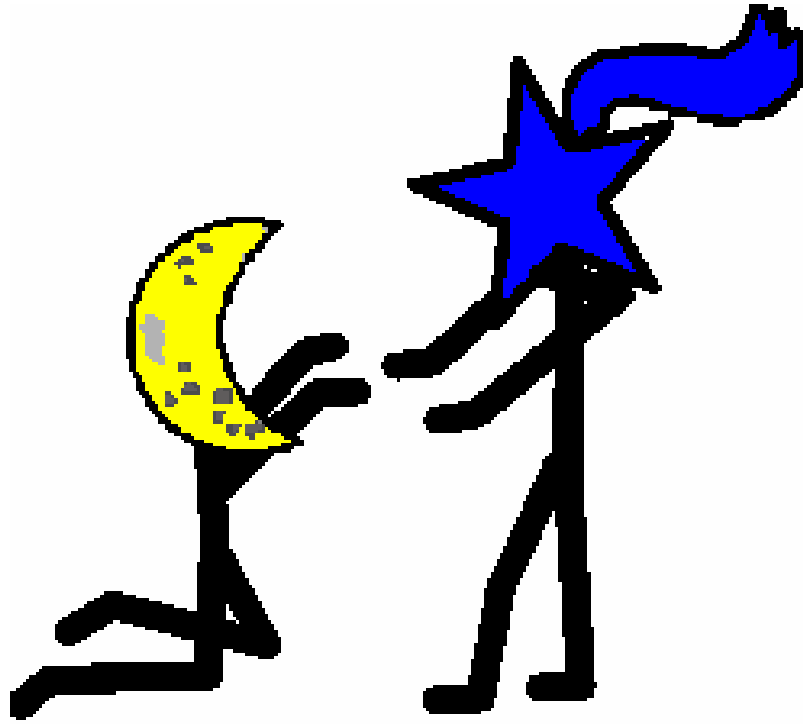




Star comes to school with Mom. She walks slowly and holds Mom's hand, with her eyes watching and her feet moving forward.

Star helps Moon up.

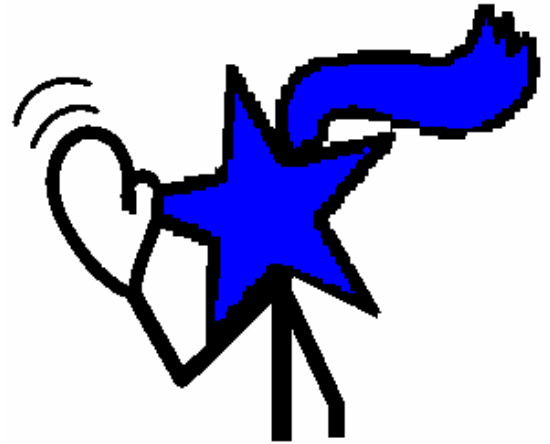
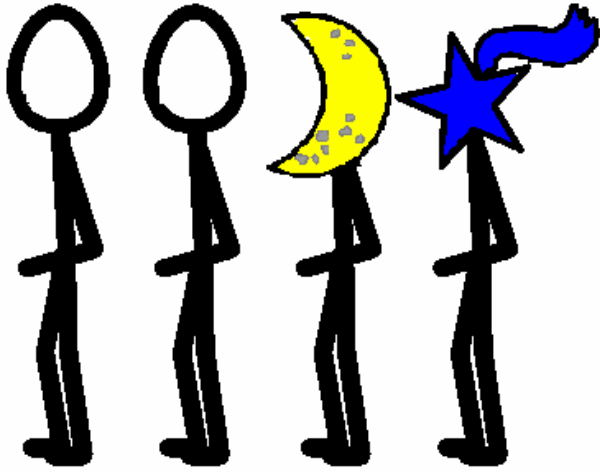
Questions to ask:

Did Star fall down? Why not?

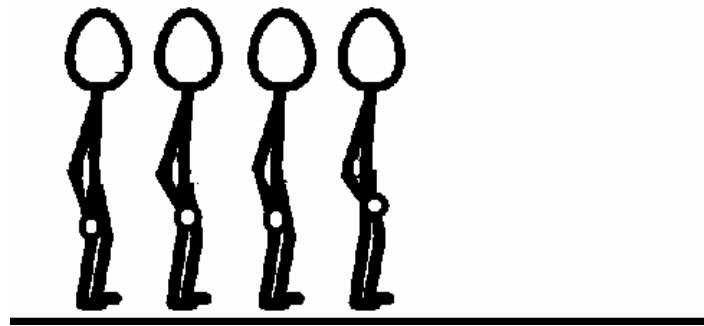
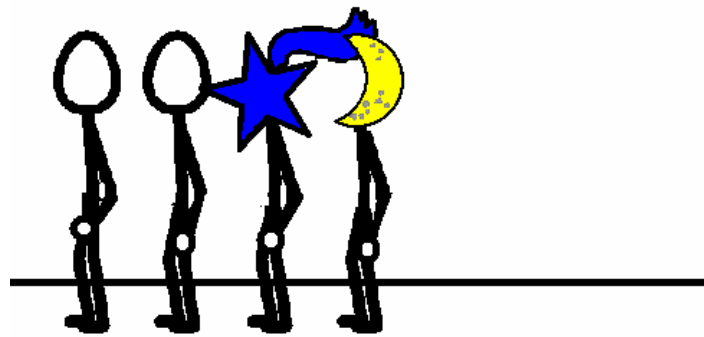
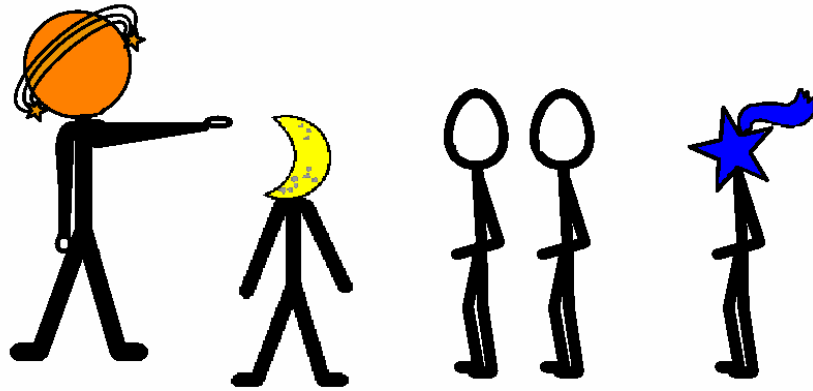
What does it mean to be safe and healthy?



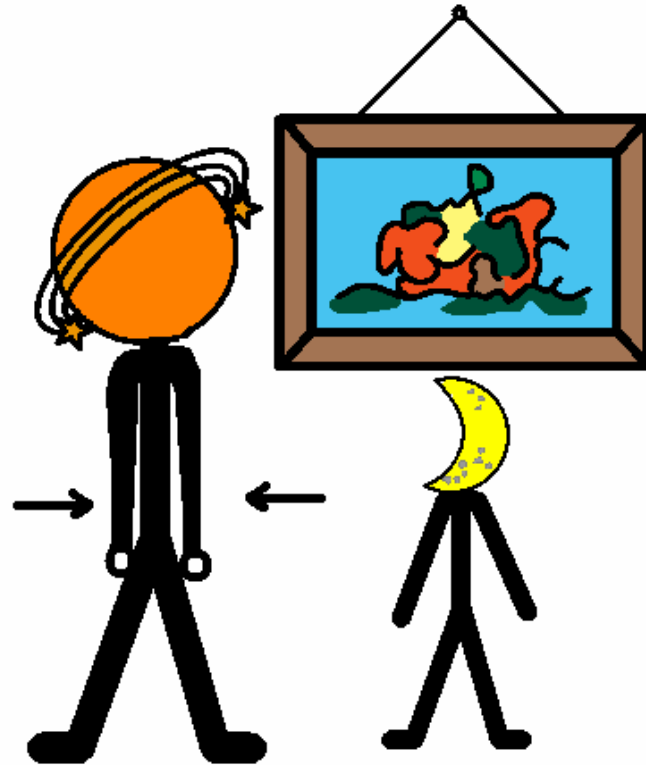
Star and Moon line up with their class to walk down the hallway. Star follows the class. She waves at a passing class.

The teacher reminds Moon to get back in line and to stay with the class on the right side.



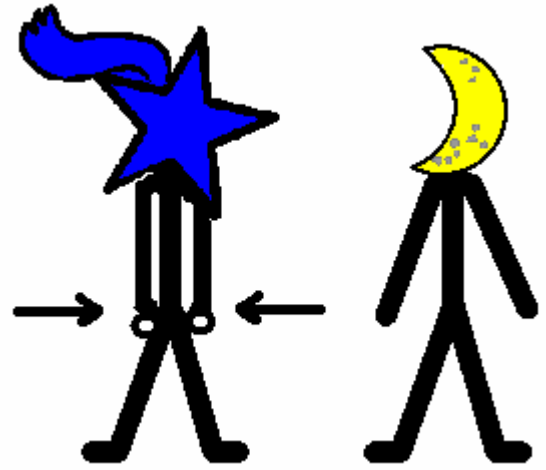
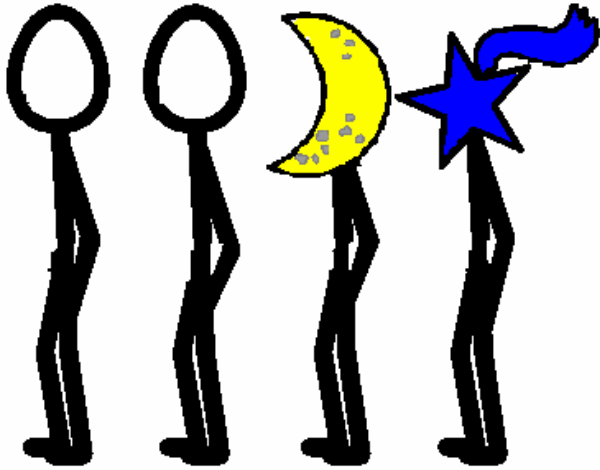
Moon listens but reaches out to touch the artwork on the wall. He is reminded to keep hands to self.

Questions to ask:

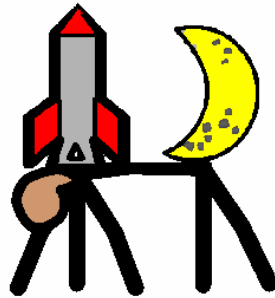
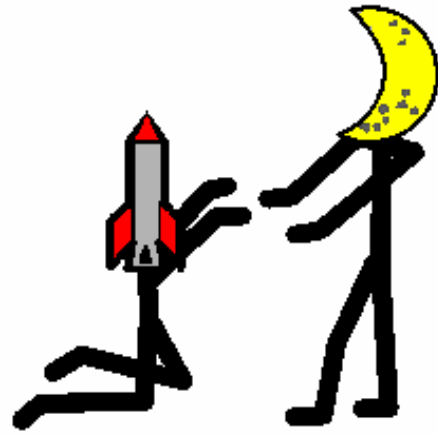
How can we help Moon? (Line basics)

How does Star greet others?

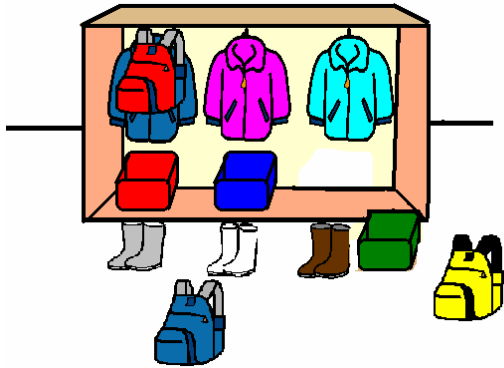
What does it mean to be respectful?

They come to the coat rack and hang up their belongings. They see some backpacks on the floor. They pick them up.
